Where will we meet?

In the school library (in the careers area) which is a quiet and private space. In exceptional circumstances you may meet at home or via Teams.





What will you give me?

- Accurate and up-to-date independent and impartial advice
- The opportunity to complete online careers quizzes and skills surveys and assessments
- Alternative sources of information and help, if required
- A personalised action plan
- Reflection, challenge, motivation and self belief.

How should I prepare?

Ask yourself the following;

- Where am I now?
- What ideas do I have?
- What have I explored / researched?
- What do I need help with?
- What thoughts do I have about the future?
