



- 1. LMI WORDSEARCH A great starter activity to introduce the key terms of LMI
- 2. **LMI FILL IN THE BLANKS ACTIVITY –** A useful activity to help pupils understand what LMI is, key terms and why it is useful
- 3. LMI HARD SKILLS MATCHING ACTIVITY Many pupils will not know what hard skills are. Hard skills are part of the skill set that is required to do a job. They include the expertise needed to do a job successfully. Hard skills are posted in job listing and adverts. In the LMI booklet in each sector area there are the top hard skills included in job listings in each sector. Ask student to match the description of the hard skill to the hard skill title. This activity will allow pupils to explore the hard skills employers all looking for in each sector area.
- 4. LMI BLACK COUNTRY COMPANIES LOGO ACTIVITY Ask pupils to use the LMI booklet to research the top 10 companies in each sector – Can they match the correct logo to the correct company and sector?
