

Y7 Catch-Up

The Summerhill Y7 Literacy Catch-Up Programme is designed to support year 7 students where data indicates that they did not achieve the expected standard in reading at the end of key stage 2. The aim of the programme to offer additional support to these students so that they can catch up with their peers and have a secure literacy foundation for KS3 and KS4.

Summerhill uses Lexia, an online resource which offers a bespoke programme of study, to help students catch up with their peers. It has been designed to help struggling and nearly proficient readers become proficient readers and confident learners. The personalised programme aims to address gaps in fundamental literacy skills while helping students build the higher-order skills they need to fully engage with the whole curriculum.

This runs as an after-school session, alongside additional work at home, to help students fill in any literacy gaps they may have.
