Young Carers

A young carer is identified as anyone under the age of 18 years old that provides unpaid care to a family member who is disabled, physically or mentally ill, or missuses substances. . A 'young adult carer' is anyone up to the age of 25. Alongside normal day-to-day activities like school and socialising, young carers may also have to cook, clean and go food shopping. They may also have to help with personal activities such as

You may have read in the news this week about the case of Child Q who was strip search in a school by two female Metropolitan Police Officers. There are a number of shocking aspects to the case including the fact that no one from the police or school spoke to the parent. The review report is 'clear that the strip search of Child Q should never have happened and there was no reasonable justification for it.'
