Road Safety – Cycling to School

As the weather gets warmer and summer is slowly creeping in, more students may be thinking of cycling into school. We have had reports from the general public about some of our students riding on the road with other students on their handle bars, swerving in and out of traffic and riding on the road the wrong way. Please can you discuss this with your child and reiterate the points below about road safety:

- Wear a helmet whilst cycling on the road
- Ride in a position where you can be clearly see and be seen Do not cycle on the wrong side of the road or weave in and out of traffic
- Do not jump red lights •
- Signal clearly at all times and make eye contact with other road • users, especially at junctions, so you know you have been seen
- It's an offence to ride at night without a front white light, back red ٠ light and back red reflector
- Do not cycle next to a friend on the road Always cycle single file
- Do not cycle with a friend on the handle bars in the road
